Q1: You are currently employed as a(n)____. 80% indicated full time.

Q2: In which state is your community college or 2Y technical located? 20 different states, more than 1/3 from the Northeast.

Q3: Is your college an access institution? 58/60 yes.

Q4: Is your college considered a minority-serving institution? 62% yes.

Q5: What is the annual student enrollment at your institution (FTE)? 84% of respondents indicated more than 5000 students.

Q6: Does your institution offer technical coursework (automotive, HVAC, biotechnology)? 84% yes.

Q7: Does your institution offer AA/AS degrees for transfer to baccalaureate programs? 100% yes.

Q8: Do you have state-wide articulations to 4-year colleges that benefit your institution's students? 60/61 yes.

Q9: Does your institution offer baccalaureate degrees? 11/61 yes.

Q10: Describe your institution. 48% indicated autonomous. 52% indicated part of a larger system.

Q11: How far away is the closest 4-year college/university to your institution? Most responded distance of within 20 miles.

Q12: Do you work with local K-12 biology educators? 28 no. 32 yes.

Q13: In which areas of professional development (pedagogy or discipline knowledge) are you interested in learning more about? Answers varied and wide spread.

Q14: What are the two greatest barriers to your continued professional development? Top answers were funding and time away from the classroom.
